



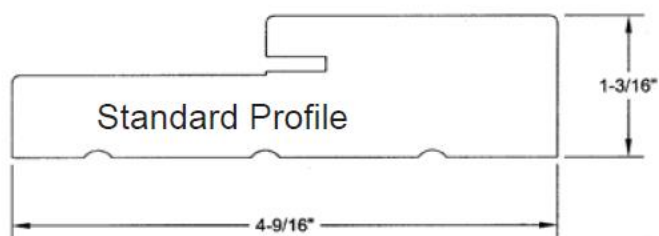
Eastern White Pine

Finger Jointed Eastern White Pine is native to Canada and is the premium wood used as a standard in the fenestration industry. Its slow growth forms very narrow growth rings allowing it to be routed, notched, screwed and stapled without the risk of splintering and cracking.

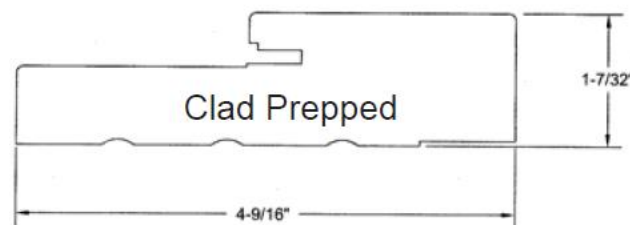
The finger joint process, glues together smaller pieces of wood with reversed grains to remove knots and to create a much more stable product that will not twist or bend.

“Clad Prepped” profile allows for easier installation of PVC cladding.

4 9/16” Door Jamb profiles:

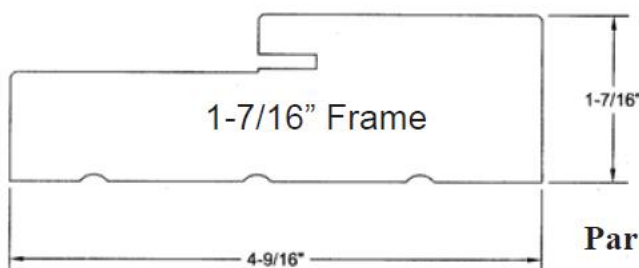

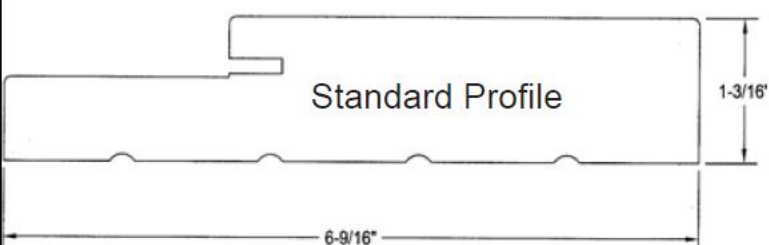

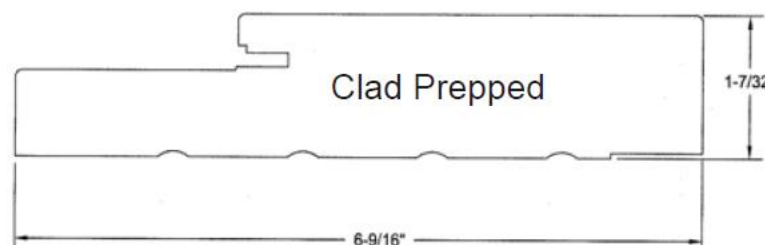

6 9/16” Door Jamb profiles:

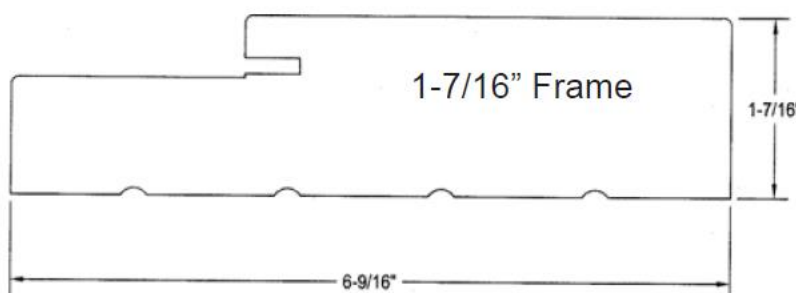
